Examination of Srđan Manojlović

Srđan Manojlović joined the unit at the beginning of 1994, having previously served as active military personnel. In the unit, he served as the commander's deputy in charge of logistics, organization, mobilization and keeping records.

Vukov's status in the unit

The witness claimed that Aleksandar Vukov was the commander's deputy between his arrival in the unit and his wounding.

Knowledge of the execution

The witness said he had no knowledge whatever of the execution. He said that he first saw the footage being shown at the Milošević trial.

The unit's links with the Republic of Serbia

In reply to a question by the injured parties' legal representative, the witness said that the members of the 'Škorpioni' unit wore a tricolour emblem on their uniforms. Asked what the emblem stood for, the witness replied: 'Why, that's the emblem of the Republic of Serbia.'
