Examination of witness Željko Delić

The witness joined the unit in February or March 1994, having previously served in an RSK army unit deployed in the neighbouring village of Nijemci. He was attracted by the pay which he said was about 250 German marks. He contacted a man named Ljubobratović whom knew from the field, and Ljubobratović arranged an interview with the unit's commander, after which the witness was admitted. His period of service in the unit is not entered in his military service booklet.

The witness did not remember that commander Slobodan Delić had security guards and thought that Petrašević was his driver and Vukov his deputy. He never saw Vukov give an order. He also remembered that a platoon commander was a soldier nicknamed 'Crnogorac' (Montenegrin) and also recalled another called 'Đole Šiptar'.
