The film follows the efforts of the filmmaker and the family to establish what happened to a 15-year old boy who, together with three other men, disappeared during the Srebrenica genocide. The search is based on statements taken from the four by Serb military police on 23 July 1995, which prove they were still alive after the main executions took place after the fall of Srebrenica from 11 to 19 July.

As the story unfolds, we discover new and heartbreaking details about the fate of the four, about the act of humanity by a Serb family who tried to save them and the cruelty they suffer today from their neighbors because of it, about the personal dramas of families who still wait for news about their loved ones, and about the state which rewards perpetrators with impunity and employment.

Several stories come together into a mosaic that is the portrait of today's Bosnia, a place scarred by atrocities for decades to come.
